Exchange your students and employees with schools
in Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein!

What is the project's aim?

To send students and employees abroad to improve their knowledge and skills

What can you do in the project?

- Exchange groups of pupils
- Go on study or teaching stays
- Have a traineeship and an internship
- Do job shadowing

What topic will you stand out with?

Prepare mobilities of students from disadvantaged groups or students – future teacher and get extra points in the selection process.

Is this project for you?

- Czech pre-primary, primary and secondary schools and universities, Czech school founders (regional authorities and municipalities) and Czech national institutions acting in the area of school education can apply for the project
- At least one institution from Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein must be the partner
- Pupils, students and employees of the institutions participating in the project can take part in the project activities

How long can the project be?

13 months

What is the grant amount and what it can be used for?

- You can get 1 500 – 100 000 EUR to finance the project, co-financing is not required
- It is possible to pay travel and subsistence costs related to the stay abroad, language training of the participants, special support for disadvantaged participants and project promotion and administration

When can you submit the application?

From November 6, 2020 to February 10, 2021.
